• Concession Stand \$405 for KMA volleyball. Mayhew's were only present. Middle school game on Thursday and have Volleybros. Game is at 6:30. December 18 can open stand, but have family obligation. Will be back to clean up. School out is December 17. January have Jan 7 and Jan 14 are double headers. Mr. Bissen will assist with starting items. Still need volunteers. When Mr. Clark sends out link via email, get additional help. Supplies are hit and miss, dependent on availability. State made \$50 more than Loess Hills, over \$4000 each. Haven't gotten reimbursement from Loess Hills (gate admission). Custodian fees need to come out of reimbursement. Mr. Clark to follow up. Have paid Booster Club for pop.

Old Business

- Uniforms for SWIMBA clean between marching band and trip. Band parents have paid for in past. Will pay for this year. This was confirmed by previous minutes and Band President. Need to confirm have correct uniforms pulled. Honor Guard individuals do not need to have cleaned, as have not been worn.
- o Annual cleanings are done after winter break that requires the purchase orders.
- New racks have not arrived yet, still en-route.
- New cape for Drum Major, as current is worn. Discussion of providing Drum Major with cape.

New Business

- Concert band clothes arrived today. Clothes have been paid. To be delivered this week as need to be hemmed. Discussion of having parents present during measurements/fitting next year during camp.
- Uniforms SWIHB kids done for need in January. Will have to look at individual kids who are traveling and whether need to be cleaned for January.
- No meeting planned for December.
- Usually do red ribbons/bow ties for Christmas concert. Holiday concert needs for December.
- December 13th concert; after that start organizing items (uniforms, instruments) for taking to Atlantic for travel for SWIHMB. No flip folders, not hats (wear baseball caps).
 One backpack or carry-on allowed. NOT checking bags. Shoes, white caps, socks, white honor band shirt go in garment bags.
- Banners (school logo) go around drum major stands was noticed at various competitions, is this a possibility for our kids. Cost approx. \$1500 each, availability for our stands? Will look into – would need to possibly upgrade stand. Could possibly see if Joe Designer can do.

 - Concert attire stitch tape. Dresses are ankle length.
 - Pep band schedule are required. Rich to send link to Mr. Clark for Sign Up Genius. Drummers and Color Guard are required to work concession stand as they all cannot play during pep band, and lots of money goes towards instruments, equipment.
 - Nashville final list is in place. If highlighted means items are missing.
 Chaperones go to board members first. Need 4 female chaperones. April 13-18th.
